



Rod Machovec, Guitar Teacher

Rod Machovec's teaching, performing and recording career has spanned over three decades. He also spends a lot of time arranging and composing for guitar and is a sought-after adjudicator. His styles range from classical to jazz, rock to world music.

In the early years while still in his teens, he studied with Brad Roberts of the "Crash Test Dummies". He went on to be the lead guitarist of "Nuthin' Pritti" recording the self-titled EP in 1985.

Shifting to full-time classical music, Rod was a student of Norbert Kraft at the University of Toronto. He also studied with Sharon Isbin at the Aspen School of Music. He holds an ARCT in Classical guitar performance.

He has five albums to his credit and is regularly heard on the radio. Rod has been a member of the Manitoba Registered Music Teachers' Association for 25 years.
